

## Manager, Risk and Compliance

**Location:** Singapore

As the *Manager, Risk and Compliance* for New Forests' operations in Singapore, this role is responsible for managing the end-to-end compliance risk management program. This role reports directly to the *Head of Risk and Compliance*, based in Sydney, Australia.

- Advising management on the implementation of compliance risk management programs.
- Managing the business' compliance risk management (CRMP) program; developing compliance risk management strategies and working closely with business heads to ensure that the processes are adhered to at the operational level.
- Liaising with auditors on risk management and compliance related matters.
- Supporting management in reporting to the boards on risk and compliance matters.
- Supporting the Risk and Compliance team in maintaining the firm's risk & compliance programs.
- Advising management on the company's compliance with laws and regulations of a MAS regulated funds management company
- Participating in global and regional projects
- Educating and training employees on regulations, company policies and industry practices
- Keeping abreast of internal standards and business goals
